In this month of October, after an extended period of drought, the rain finally came to Pantanal. The intense drought makes fires more likely, but we are happy to share that Pantanal, a biome which is highly dependent on water, is now flooded, beautiful and splendid.

The diversity and beauty of this biome are a part of our history, it was in Pantanal where it all started. In 2011, when Onçafari was created, we began habituating jaguars in Caiman Pantanal, taking our first steps towards the conservation of these large felines. Since then, we expanded our distribution and our objectives. It feels like a movie in my mind, for not even in my dreams I would've imagined Onçafari would grow as much.

Celebrations last year were postponed due to the pandemics, but this year, on the 17th of November, we'll celebrate our trajectory in a conservation event, Onçafari 10+1.

Straight from the field - Children in nature!

On the 12th of October, besides being Children's Day, we also celebrate the National Maned Wolf Day, species in the endangered list in Brazil, their main threats being deforestation, car accidents and diseases transmitted by domestic animals. In this children's month, we are very pleased to get records from our camera traps from Nhorinhá's new cubs, a female habituated and monitored by our team since 2018 in Pousada Trijunção. Scenes like this stress the important work developed by our team, which every day goes to the field to observe and study this unique animal, and promote this species conservation through ecotourism, scientific research and environment education.

In the science branch, the article named "Wildfires disproportionately affected jaguars in the Pantanal" was published in October, in which Onçafari contributed with data and revisions. Pantanal biome has been strongly affected by fires in the last years and this situation will surely repeat itself in the next years due to extreme and prolonged droughts. This study showed that the 2020 fires impacted 45% of jaguar population in the biome and 79% of the areas in which these animals lived.

This work proposes a better regulation for the use of fires, creation of more conservation units and firefighting training for quick and effective responses.

Onçafari & TUC Glasses



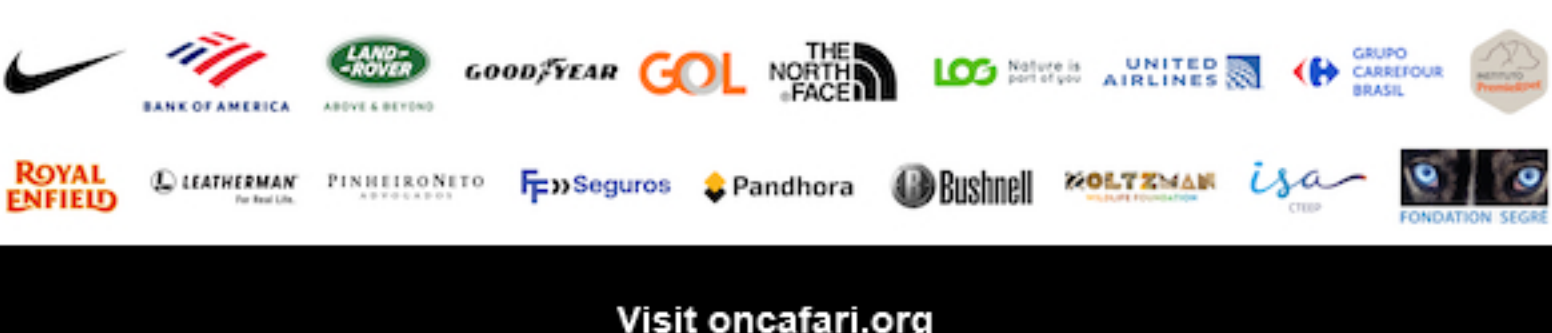

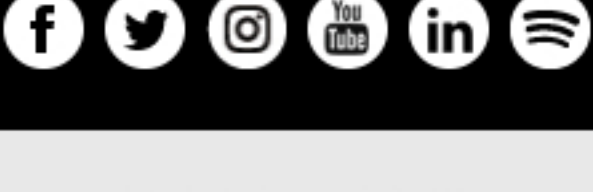
